## CITY OF THE VILLAGE OF DOUGLAS ALLEGAN COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDINANCE NO. 02-2021

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE OF DOUGLAS – REZONE ST. PETER'S SUBDIVISION; 300 ST. PETER'S DRIVE; AND PART OF 324 W. CENTER STREET ZONED R-2 RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO R-4 HARBOR RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

Councilmember Seabert supported by Councilmember Mooradian, moved the adoption of the following ordinance:

**WHEREAS**, the City of the Village of Douglas received petition(s) November 11, 2020 and November 25, 2020 on behalf of individuals with ownership interest(s) ("Petitioners") for rezoning;


**WHEREAS,** in support of the petition(s), the "Applicant," City of the Village of Douglas, has submitted an application for rezoning of the St. Peter's Subdivision; 300 St. Peter's Drive; and part of 324 W. Center Street from its current zoned R-2 Residential District to R-4 Harbor Residential District status;

WHEREAS, pursuant to and in compliance with Act 110 of 2006 of the Public Acts of Michigan, as amended, being the Zoning Enabling Act, the City's Planning Commission conducted a public hearing concerning the petition(s) and rezoning on January 13, 2021, after proper publication of a notice first published on December 29, 2020 in the Holland Sentinel, and on December 31, 2020 in the Commercial Record; both newspapers of general circulation in the City;

**WHEREAS**, the City's Planning Commission arrived at findings of fact in support of the "Petitioners" and "Applicant," recommending the approval of the rezoning at its meeting of January 13, 2021.

## THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE OF DOUGLAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Amendment.** The City of the Village of Douglas Zoning Map is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:



**Section 2. Publication**. Within fifteen (15) days of its adoption, this Ordinance or a summary thereof, as required by law, shall be published by the City Clerk in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be effective twenty (20) days after its publication, or a publication of a summary thereof, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.
