## **Process:**

- A. An application for acceptance of a private street shall be submitted to the Planning Department on a form for that purpose together with an application fee, as determined by the City Council.
- B. Upon receipt of a complete application, a preliminary meeting with the applicant, the City Manager and the City Engineer shall be required. The purpose of this meeting shall include discussion of all known items of concern related to the existing private street, including but not limited to drainage, construction, sidewalks, lighting, and all underground utilities.
- C. Following the preliminary meeting, the applicant shall submit a detailed engineering plan which specifies the proposed construction or reconstruction of all necessary improvements required to bring the road into compliance with the standards of this ordinance. The proposed plan shall include an accurate and up to date cost estimate for all proposed improvements as well as a signed statement from at least 60% of the property owners having direct access to the private street which verifies their knowledge and support for the acceptance of the street into the public network as well as the potential costs associated with any required improvements to bring the road into compliance with City standards. All costs associated with improving or upgrading the private road shall be borne by the property owners with direct access to the private road.
- D. A review meeting with the City Engineer and City staff may be appropriate.
- E. Upon determining that the application and plans are complete, the City Manager shall direct the Clerk to provide notice to all property owners within 300 feet of the private street being requested for such acceptance that the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on the application.
- F. In addition, any property owner who lives on or uses the private street as access to their property will be notified of the hearing.
- G. The Planning Commission shall, within a reasonable amount of time after the public hearing, give a recommendation to the City Council on whether to deny, approve or approve with conditions the request. The recommendation shall include an evaluation of the proposed street design and construction as well as a review from the City Engineer.
- H. The City Council shall then hold a meeting within a reasonable period of time to make a decision. If approved, a special assessment district shall be created at the same time that the private road is accepted. The City shall contract to have the private road improved as necessary to comply with local ordinances and all costs shall be apportioned to the properties on an annual basis.
