Members shall be appointed for four (4) year terms, only as terms of the former members expire or vacancies otherwise occur. A member shall hold office until the member's successor is appointed.

Members shall be appointed by the chief executive officer (Mayor) of the municipality, subject to approval by the governing body of the municipality.

Not less than a majority of the members shall be persons having an interest in property located in the downtown district or officers, members, trustees, principals, or employees of a legal entity having an interest in property located in the downtown district. An appointment to fill a vacancy shall be made by the chief executive officer of the municipality for the unexpired term only.

The DDA shall be under the supervision and control of a board consisting of the chief executive officer of the municipality, or their designee from the governing body of the municipality, and not less than 8 or more than 12 members. Not less than 1 of the members shall be a resident of the downtown district, if there are 100 or more persons residing within downtown district.
