**Applications Accepted Through September 13, 2023, until 4:30 pm**  
**Lottery Drawing on September 14, 2023 @ 2:00 pm at City Hall**  
**Results Posted September 15, 2023**

A lottery system will be used to obtain a two-year seasonal slip at Douglas Marina for the 2024 and 2025 boating season. There are 13 slips available. It is important to note this slip lottery is for two years only.

**Occupancy Dates**

April 15, 2024 – October 15, 2024

April 15, 2025 – October 15, 2025

**Cost Per Slip**

\$2,000 per year

**Lottery Rules:**

- One entry per registered boat
- Slips are non-transferable
- Slip assignment will be determined by staff
- Valid entries require the submission of a formal application
- Applications will be accepted through September 13, 2023 until 4:30 pm
- If selected, applicants must provide liability coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000, naming the City of Douglas as additional insured, copy of insurance, and copy of registration that lists the applicant as the registered owner
- A deposit of 25 percent will be due two weeks after award of slip assignment to secure slip. Unpaid deposit will result in a loss of reservation. Remaining balance is due to the City by April 1, 2024.

To enter the lottery a person must complete the attached form. All entries will be taken by mail, email, or in person. No phone entries will be allowed. Applications will be accepted through September 13, 2023, until 4:30 pm. Applications are posted on the City's website [www.douglasmi.gov](http://www.douglasmi.gov) or can be picked up at Douglas City Hall.

The lottery will take place publicly at City Hall on September 14, 2023, at 2:00 pm.  
Lottery results will be posted September 15, 2023, at City Hall and on our website at [www.douglasmi.gov](http://www.douglasmi.gov).

The following restrictions shall apply to the type of watercraft eligible for a municipal boat slip. 1) Only one watercraft shall be allowed in any assigned slip. 2) No watercraft shall have a beam/width exceeding nine and one-half (9 ½) feet. 3) No watercraft shall have a draft in excess of three (3) feet. 4) No watercraft shall exceed forty (40) feet in length. NOTE: City staff reserve the right to assign the best fitting slip for the length, beam, and draft of the watercraft listed on the application.

Douglas Marina is a public park. Included with slip is electrical service, water, public showers, public restrooms, public picnic area, and public parking.

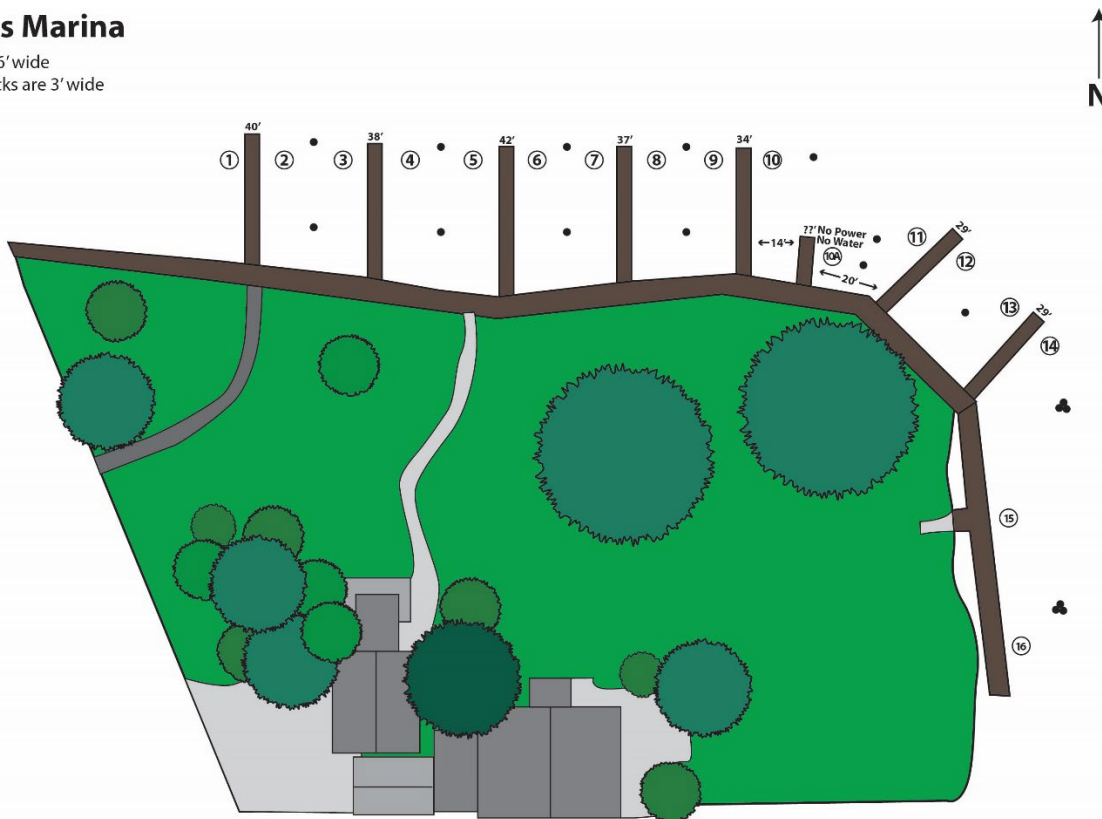
