**200 Blue Star "Burrito Removal" Update:** Finally! The large pile of debris, also known as "the burrito" on the north end of the 200 Blue Star Highway site is still on track to be removed on Monday, December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

This debris may contain some level of contamination, which we want to assure the public, will be handled with the utmost care and in accordance with all applicable environmental regulations. We want to emphasize that the level of contamination in the debris is below a threshold where it will not jeopardize public health when removed. The removal process is being conducted by trained professionals using industry-standard procedures to ensure the safety of both the workers and the surrounding residents and businesses.

**Public Input Session:** The Public Input Session for 200 Blue Star Highway will take place on Tuesday, December 19, 2023, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Douglas City Hall. The session will also be available via zoom. If you cannot make it, an online survey will be available. Please watch for official postings at City Hall, on the city website, and the City's social media pages.
