It is the intent of the City of Douglas to enter into a Purchase Agreement with the Bidder whose Bid is the most conforming to the RFB and will be most advantageous to the City of Douglas, provided it has been submitted in completion and accordance with the Bid requirements. Bids will be reviewed by a committee, and the selected bid will be presented to City Council for consideration. If a Bid is selected, it will be the most advantageous regarding price and other factors which the City of Douglas may consider. The City expressly reserves the right to accept a Bid other than the highest Bid and reserves the right to negotiate any terms prior to a Purchase Agreement. City Council has the sole authority to award Purchase Agreements at their pleasure.
