Beery Field Playground Perimeter: The City would like to thank the Douglas Department of Public Works for all their work around the perimeter of the Beery Field playground area. They are sprucing things up and continuing to make it a great place for families to enjoy. Please check it out!

REMINDER-Trash Receptacles Placement and Storage: Please remember to follow the guidelines under City ordinance number *54.07 RECEPTACLES*, as it relates to the set-out, and storage of trash containers. The City has received numerous complaints about trash cans being left out beyond the times cited in the ordinance and will address any violations accordingly.

**All portable receptacles shall be stored upon the premises and shall not be set out for collection prior to 12:00 p.m. proceeding the day of collection, and after the receptacles are emptied, they shall be returned to their place of storage on the same day collections are made. No empty portable receptacles shall be stored on city property, including the public right-of-way, sidewalks, and streets. **

Pedestrian Crosswalks: Please be mindful that yielding to pedestrians in designated (and marked) crosswalks is the law. We want to ensure everyone's safety. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

415 Wiley Road: The City Council conducted a workshop on Monday, June 3rd, where a decision was made to start discussions regarding the 415 Wiley Road property build-out for a future city hall and police department, with Carbon Six Construction. The Council will be hosting another workshop, on Monday, June 10th at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall, to discuss the build-out a bit more, and ask follow-up questions. The City Council has not yet determined if the project will move forward, but is performing their due diligence to ensure whichever direction they decide to move into, is in the best interest of the community.
