



City of the Village of Douglas Administration Review Week of June 17th, 2024

415 Wiley Road: The City Council has agreed to hire Carbon Six Construction to commence the design phase for the 415 Wiley Road space where the goal is to move City Hall, the Police Department, and add office space for the Department of Public Works. Once the design phase is complete, and Council is comfortable with the direction and pricing, the next step will be to pass an agreement to start construction.

Brush Pick-Up: Brush pick-up will take place on Tuesday, June 18th for locations on the East side of Blue Star Highway, and on Tuesday, June 25th on the West side of Blue Star Highway.

The City WILL NOT pick up: material from lot clearing operations, tree removal (including stumps), large landscape debris, railroad ties, pet waste, bricks, lumber, fence debris, construction material, grass clippings, dune grass, leaves, yard waste, or garden waste (unpotted/potted plants), and brush piles that are left from contracted work or commercial landscapers.

Leaf pick-up will commence in the fall. Please refer to the City website for a copy of the pick-up schedule, or visit City Hall, where you can access the information sheet in the vestibule.

Please do not place debris in the public right-of-way and be mindful of the issues with safety this can cause.
