**Douglas Marina Residential Buildings Demolition Notification:** The City of Douglas will be demolishing the residential buildings located at the Douglas Marina. We understand that having a demolition site in the vicinity of a residence or boat slip can be less than desirable. It is our goal to do our utmost to consider the impact on the neighborhood and slip holders when planning the upcoming demolition work. The demolition work will start on August 5, weather permitting, and should be completed by the end of the week. Restoration work will include 3” of topsoil and hydro seed. No road closure is expected to take place and dust will be mitigated with the use of water if needed. Please use the parking across from the marina during this demolition.

We apologize for any inconvenience that this work causes, and we appreciate your cooperation while we complete this demolition. For everyone’s safety, please stay away from any active work zone and obey all signs or requests from the Department of Public Works.

**Social District Expansion:** The City Council approved revising the existing social district map to include Beery Field. The Michigan Liquor Control Commission just needs to review the new map, along with the management and maintenance documentation, and then give their approval. If an event is taking place in Beery Field and there is a vendor selling alcoholic beverages, social district beverages cannot be taken into Beery Field. Outside of these events, social district beverages served by those businesses who have a state license to do so, can be consumed in that area. They must be in an approved social district cup with the date and time the beverage was sold written on the cup.

**Recycling Bins:** Please adhere to the curbside recycling schedule which is every other week. Do not place bins at the curb when it is not a recycling week. We appreciate your cooperation.

**Brush Pick-Up:** If debris other than brush (wood), is left at the curb on a scheduled brush pick-up date, it will not be picked up. Please do not place dune grass, grass clippings, potted plants, mulch, flowerbed/pot material, large landscaping project material, or leaves at the curbside. (Leaf pick-up will resume in the fall). Thank you again for your anticipated cooperation.
