Tri-Community Wildlife Committee: The City of Douglas, City of Saugatuck, and Saugatuck Township have officially made their appointments to the Tri-Community Wildlife Committee. The City of Douglas will be taking the lead in scheduling meetings for the committee and will be hosting them at Douglas City Hall. The date and time for the first meeting is forthcoming.

The purpose of the Committee is to seek options and make recommendations to manage the overgrowth of deer and other wildlife within the jurisdictions of the City of Douglas, Saugatuck Township, and the City of Saugatuck. The Authority will discuss wildlife management strategies, particularly focusing on the hunting season periods set by the State of Michigan for culling purposes and make recommendations to the respective councils and boards of each community.

How the Program Works:

• Passports: Customers can pick up a passport from Douglas City Hall or any participating business from November 1-November 30th.

- Collecting Stamps: As customers visit participating locations, they will collect stamps. No purchase is necessary for them to receive a stamp just a visit!
- Completion Requirements: Once customers have collected stamps from at least 50% of the participating businesses listed in the passport, they can submit their completed passport.
- Submission Options: Completed passports can be turned in at:
 - Douglas City Hall
 - Any participating business (including yours)
 - The Light Night in Douglas Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony at Beery Field on Saturday, November 30th, at 6:00 p.m.

Drawing & Prizes:

- Prize Drawing: By submitting a completed passport, participants will be entered into a drawing to win one of three "downtown dollars" prizes to spend at participating businesses in the amounts of \$200.00, \$150.00 & \$100.00.
- Event Participation: Customers do not need to be present at the tree lighting event to participate in the drawing.
